What we do

NO SINGLE USE PLASTIC

We have eliminated single-use plastic bottles in our hotels. Guests can find refillable glass water bottles in every guest room and offer toiletries in refillable dispensers rather than mini bottles.

RECYCLING

We recycle cardboard, plastic, glass, and food, and ensure unrecyclable waste go to energy recovery instead of landfill.

SAVING WATER

We save water by having water-efficient taps, showers, and toilets, and change towels and bed linen only on request.

SAVING ENERGY

We minimise our energy consumption by using 100% LED lights and implementing a key card system that automatically turns off lights and heating when guests leave their rooms.

SUSTAINABLE TRANSPORT

Below are some simple things you can do to help us protect the environment during your stay

RECYCLING

Help our housekeeping staff by not putting any liquids or food in your bins, unless they are carefully wrapped. These items can contaminate recyclable waste, making it difficult for our cleaners to separate it for recycling. Additionally, remember that minimizing waste generation is even more important than recycling.

FLUSHING

Please do not flush any items in the toilet other than toilet paper. Feminine hygiene products, paper towels, and packaging can block and pollute waterways, since none of them will dissolve.

SAVING WATER

Help us conserve water by reusing your towels and leaving them on the towel rack. Take shorter showers and avoid leaving the tap running unnecessarily.

SAVING ENERGY

Please remove your key card when leaving your room to ensure that lighting and heating are turned off when not in use.

SUSTAINABLE TRANSPORT

Explore sustainable transportation options such as renting bicycles, walking, or taking the tube. They're also faster than travelling by car.
